Thomas Rabeyron offers an overview of the possible links between psychoanalytical metapsychology and contemporary work in neuroscience concerning entropy and the free energy principle. The psychic apparatus can be considered at different levels, from the most primary to the most secondary, as having the essential function of reducing entropy and free energy. Various forms of "failure" of this process of linking, regulation and transformation of energy within the psychic apparatus could be considered as the origin of different psychopathological manifestations.

Child and Adolescent Psychoanalysis

In adolescent psychiatry, when patients present high-risk sexual behaviours, there is usually a traumatic sexual event in childhood, says Marion Robin, Aziz Essadek, Maurice Corcosa, and Gerard Shadilia. In the first stage the trauma is constituted and in the second adolescent stage the mnemonic trace leads the traumatic experience to be reproduced within a destructured psychic apparatus that's seeking restructuration through actions. These two psychopathological stages are examined in the light of the connection between Freud's paradigms of the *neurotica* and the theory of fantasy.
